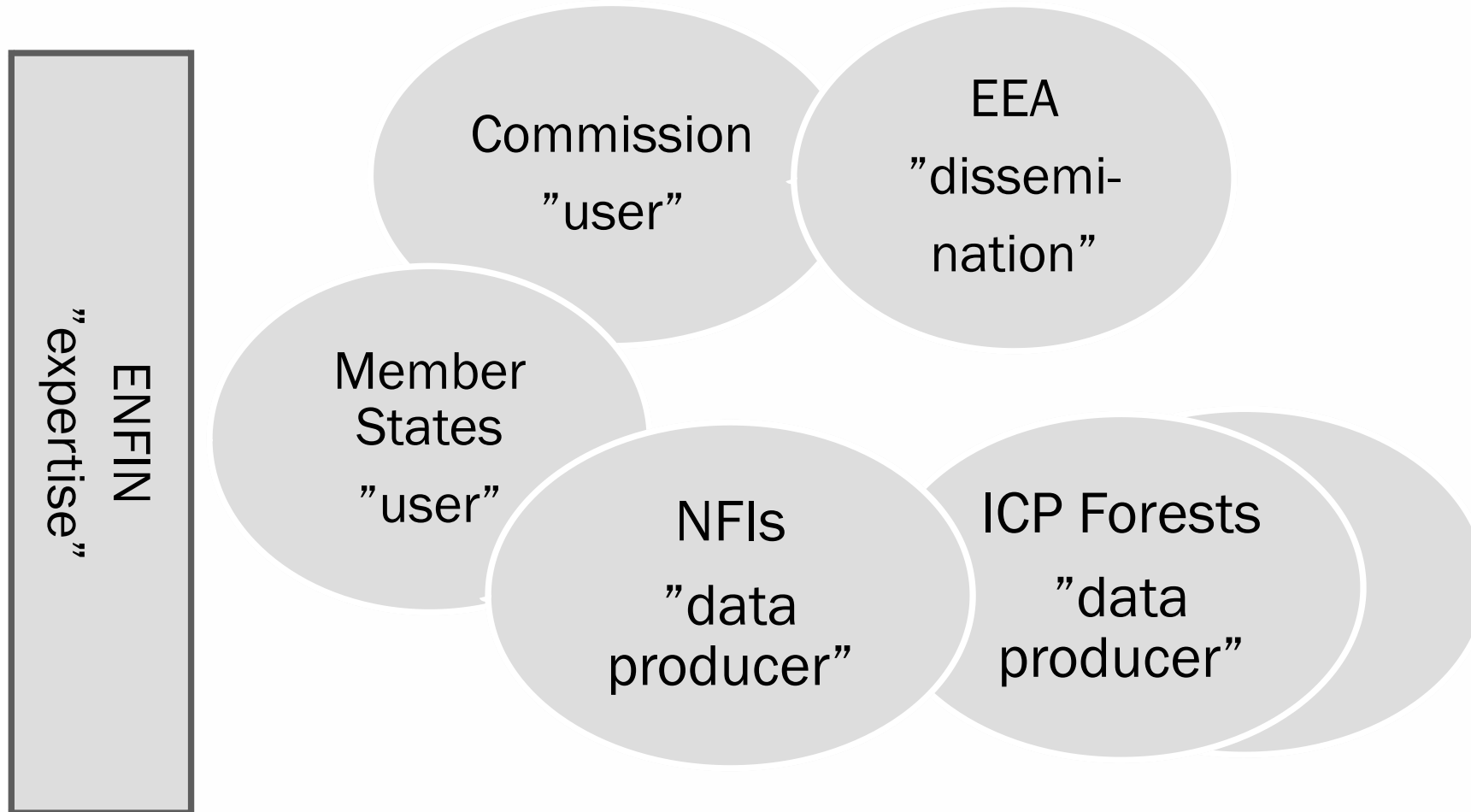

# Key Actors in EFM



# Structure and responsibilities

## Commission

- Sets the goals and requirements of indicators together with MS
- Finds resources to develop monitoring systems & harmonize data

## EEA

- Supports the Commission: checking relevance
- Shares information (FISE)

## ENFIN

- Operates and develops a common analysis platform to produce statistics and maps
- Develops methods for calculations and harmonization
- Reviews indicators and reports
- Implements QA/QC
- Possibly: coordinates the exchange of non-confidential raw data

## Member States

- Set the goals and requirements of indicators together with Commission
- Overall responsibility of NFIs
- Provide resources for NFIs
- Review produced information

## NFIs

- Collect the data
- Process the data
- Share processed data with ENFIN in harmonized format
- Review produced information
- Share expertise on use of forest data for decision making

# What "bottom-up approach" means?

- Utilization of existing systems (such as NFI, ICP Forests) for data collection, maintaining the existing long time series
- Involving MS and NFI expertise in defining and developing indicators that are relevant for EU-level decision making
- Involving MS and NFI expertise in using the information at decision making
- Processing the data to information using the existing NFI-based estimation platform developed by ENFIN/NFIs
